Must be between the ages of 7 to 25 on March 1^{st} , 2024.

Girls and Boys will be evaluated separately in each Age and Dance category.

- Master Classes are included in the registration fee. If you wish to pay later for Master classes, the price will be \$40 per each master class.
- We holding up to 10 Classes during the festival. Mater Classes will be lead and observe by our Judges on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- Our judges lead master classes of Ballet, Character Dance, Contemporary and Break Dance. To attend Master classes please fill the Master classes Form. (Detailed schedule will be providing in a week before the event).
